### **1. WHEN ARE THE ELEVATE KENTUCKY SESSIONS?**

April 24-26: Western Kentucky | Know Your State

May 16-17: Eastern Kentucky | Lead Your State

June 13-14: Central Kentucky | Improve Your State + Graduation

### **2. WHAT IS THE COST FOR THE PROGRAM?**

The tuition for ELEVATE Kentucky 2019 is \$1,900. Tuition includes meals, lodging, and three action and information packed sessions. You will need to provide your transportation to the session locations.

### **3. WHO SHOULD APPLY?**

Elevate Kentucky is designed for millennials and young professionals approximately 25-35, but there is not a strict age limit. We look for individuals who are not only advancing in their careers but also involved in their communities and eager to become a stronger leader. Sessions will provide skills and tools to advance your career, your company, and your community to the next level.

### **4. WHAT DOES A TYPICAL ELEVATE SESSION LOOK LIKE?**

In Western Kentucky, there will be two overnight stays. These sessions will start mid-day on Wednesday, with a full day of programming on Thursday, and will conclude mid-day on Friday. In Eastern and Central Kentucky, ELEVATE Kentucky will begin at lunch on Thursday, with programming in the afternoon and into the evening with dinner. The sessions will continue with additional programming the next morning and conclude mid-day.
